

HOW TO PLANT A TREE



YOU WILL NEED:

- A tree (of course- see how to pick a tree for more info)
- A spade
- A stake and guard (if needed)
- A pot (if not planting in the ground)

1

Mark where you want to plant the tree. (For more than one plant approx. 2m apart.)

2

Dig a hole slightly wider and deeper than the roots of your tree. Loosen the soil around the edges.

3

Put the tree in the whole so that the mark from the soil on the tree (the collar) is level with the ground.

4

Hold your tree in place gently push back the soil, pressing it down onto the roots trying not to compact the soil.

5

Press the stake into the ground to hold the tree straight and place a guard around your tree if there is risk from animals.
